Further detail on eligible countries

The Covid pandemic proved that the majority of employees can work from anywhere; and now employees want the flexibility to work from wherever they choose. Countries are recognising this, and **there are now over 50 countries offering Digital Nomad Visas (DNVs)**.

A DNV enables the holder to legally work in a foreign country. They typically don't involve employer sponsorship, allow the holder to work, and usually permit a longer duration of stay. Here are some examples to give you an idea of where remote workers are being welcomed.
