

Country Schedule – Malaysia

1. About this Country Schedule

This Country Schedule is applicable where the Agreement is entered into in the country or territory set forth above. Capitalized terms used in this Country Schedule but not defined have the meanings given in the Agreement.

2. Governing law and dispute resolution

The Agreement and any dispute arising in connection with it, whether contractual or non-contractual, is governed by and shall be construed in accordance with the laws of Malaysia. Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to the Agreement shall be referred for arbitration at the Asian International Arbitration Centre (the “Centre”) under the rules of the Centre. The arbitral tribunal shall have a panel of three (3) arbitrators. The language to be used in the arbitral proceedings shall be English and the place of arbitration shall be in Kuala Lumpur. The arbitral tribunal’s decision and/or award shall be final and binding upon the parties.

3. Limitation period

With respect to the Agreement, the Limitation Act 1953 shall apply.
